GUIDE FOR SUPERVISORS

Thank you for assisting the running of the BSRA Indoor Rowing Championships. Somerville House have generously donated the use of this venue, the Performing Arts Centre, for our event.

Your main focus is to ensure that acceptable behaviour as outline below is followed:

1. Please ensure that this beautiful facility is treated with respect and all rubbish removed when the event concludes.
2. Please do not allow food into the venue. Food is to be consumed outside in the service area.
3. Sometimes the girls wear 'war paint' on their faces. Can you make sure that this is not left on the seating or surrounds for cleaning? If cleaning is required, your individual school will be billed for the service.
4. The girls are not permitted to stand on the seats.
5. The walkway between the stage and the spectator area can be occupied by the girls cheering on their fellow rowers. This should be monitored to ensure it doesn't get out of hand.
6. The seating plan for your school is on a separate document as is the detailed timing for the evening. Formalities begin at 5:10 pm. The first race, the year 8 Individual event, is immediately following the welcome address. The All Age Relay is the final race, scheduled at 7:20 with formalities concluding the event at 7:45pm.
