

BSRA pennant/certificate distribution instructions

Hello wonderful helpers

I have some instructions to clear up any confusion:

1. Pennants are typically for first place and certificates for second and third place
2. The underlying principle is that you have to beat someone to get a pennant/certification.
 - This is not always the case in lead up regattas and if there are three boats I am happy for three awards. Note: This WILL NOT happen in Head of the River.
3. We distribute for the first rotation of racing only
4. Invitation means they do not receive points or pennants and their entry should not be included in results.
 - Where an invitation crew finishes in the top three you must discard their result and the next crews result will be increased by one place.
5. Often I combine races (divisions) in the Division 6, 7, 8, 9
 - The results DO NOT separate out the results of the divisions separately unfortunately – so this is where you will do it manually
 - Where there are less than three boats I look at the straight results in the combined race
 - Where there are three or more boats in a division and the race is combined, I allocate a pennant/certification separately
 - Eg, GY84X+D9 AND D8
