## Rules of the Regatta

The regatta will be conducted in accordance with the Rowing Queensland Inc. Laws of Boat Racing and in conjunction with the BSRA Regatta By-Laws.

Each competitor must be eligible to compete with respect to the BSRA Regatta By-Laws. Substitutes must be advised to the judge at the finish line. No substitutes are allowed between the heat and final of any event. Withdrawals must be lodged with the judge, 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the event.

All crews must display Rowing Queensland approved bow numbers.

Lane #1 is on the Spectator side of the course (closest to the judge).

All crews must be in the starters control 5 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the event.

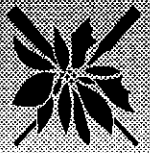
Power boats other than official regatta boats are not permitted on the course throughout the conduct of the program.

All queries regarding the conduct of racing are to be directed to the Judge. All queries regarding legality of entries and policing of BSRA Regatta By-Laws should be directed to the Regatta Committee.

# WELCOME FROM THE CHAIRMAN



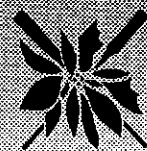
The Brisbane Schoolgirl's Rowing Association and Rowing Queensland welcome guests, parents, friends and competitors to the 1995 "Head of the River".

# HISTORY OF THE B.S.R.A



The Inaugural Schoolgirls' Head of the River, held on the Brisbane River on 13 October 1990 was orchestrated by Tony Elliot (St. Margaret's), John Hanson (Brisbane State High School) and Peter Jell (Somerville House). The seven schools that competed were All Hallows', Brisbane State High School, St Aidan's, St. Hilda's, St. Margaret's, St. Peter's, and Somerville House. Sixteen events were competed that year and the Open 8+ had three entries.

In 1991, the newly formed Brisbane Schoolgirls' Rowing Association organised the Head of the River with additional schools being Brisbane Girls' Grammar, Clayfield College, Indooroopilly State High School, Kelvin Grove State High School and Stuartholme. A number of these schools began rowing when girls had older brothers who rowed at GPS schools. A motivated parent would coach and coordinate a crew from one of the local clubs.

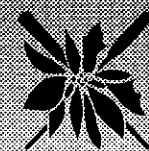
In 1992 Rockhampton Girls' Grammar rowed by invitation and Indooroopilly State High School withdrew from competition. By this time the entries in the Open 8+ had doubled to six.

In 1993 Kelvin Grove State High School and Stuartholme did not row but along with Somerset College they rowed again in 1994. 1993 saw the dominance of Brisbane State High School and Somerville House in the Open 8+ broken for the first time. Brisbane Girls Grammar became the first school to win an 8+'s race outside of State High and Somerville and Girls Grammar went on to claim the State Championship in this event.

In 1994 the Head of the River Regatta was held for the first time on Lake Wivenhoe. Eleven schools competed and this year saw the first ever heats programmed in Brisbane Schoolgirls rowing but were not rowed due to withdrawals.

In 1995 we see a further surge in the strength of Brisbane Schoolgirls Rowing with over 600 competitors in today's racing. The entries in the Open 1st 8+ have tripled since the first year and many past and present competitors have gone on to successfully represent their State and Country.

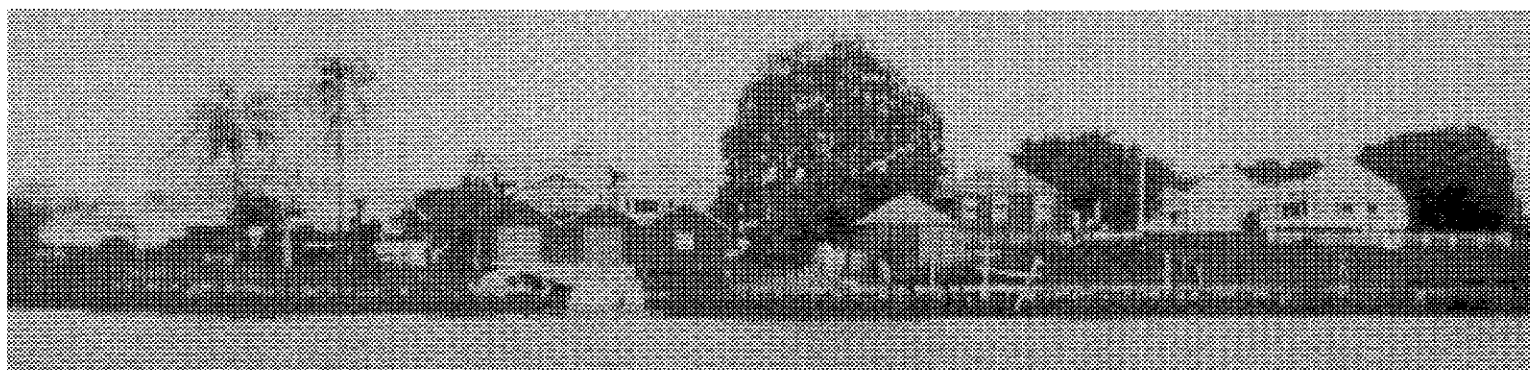
# PROFILE – NELL SLATTER



The following notes on early Women's Rowing in Queensland are by Nell Slatter - All Hallows Past Student and Queensland Rowing Representative in the 1930's.

Our club house was at Kangaroo Point, near the Customs House ferry.

The Queensland Ladies Rowing Association was formed in 1930.

Womens rowing was very active in the years before the war. In about 1940 the membership fell off.

The silting of the River was very bad and at low tide we would be unable to get our boats on the water.

During the war, several members joined the services, then married.

After the war, clubs from Bundaberg, Maryborough, Rockhampton and Tweed Heads began to show keen competition.

With the opening of the mens club to women interested in rowing, Brisbane Ladies Rowing Club folded. Those of us who were interested, were busy raising families.

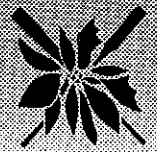


Nell Slatter's 1933 Queensland Representative Four. (Mrs Slatter is in the three seat, third from left.)

# REGATTA WATCHING GUIDE



## THE RACES

Schoolgirls race 1000 metres in all events except for eights, which are raced over 2000 metres. An Umpire follows crews on the course to ensure everyone is racing under fair and safe conditions

## THE BOATS

Shells are made of honeycomb carbon fibre, kevlar, wood or fibreglass. People who have two oars in the water are called scullers. you can row by yourself with two oars in a single (1x), with one other person in a double (2x), or with three others in a quad (4x). People with only one oar are rowers.

The normal configuration of a rowing boat has oars alternating between right and left, or Stroke and Bow sides of the boat. Rowing boats come in pairs (2), fours (4) and eight (8).

They may have a coxswain, in which case they are called a coxed pair (2+), or a coxed four (4+). The coxswain is the on-the-water coach who also steers the boat. Pairs and fours also come without coxswains (2-, 4-). The eight always has a coxswain (8+).

## WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN A GOOD CREW

**Continuous motion:** Rowing should be a continuous and fluid motion

**Synchronisation:** Rowers strive for perfect timing in all actions

**Clean Blade work:** Blades going in and coming out of the water shouldn't disturb it too much. The catch should be quick and light, the finish smooth and fluid.

**Blade heights on the feather:** As the blades are brought out of the water, they are turned flat (feathered). They should move forward horizontally at the same height, just above the water and arc rolled square (vertical) just before the catch.

**Consistent speed:** Stroke rates vary from boat to boat, depending on the numbers of rowers and sizes of athletes. At the start, the stroke rate will be higher- 40-44 strokes per minute for an eight, 36-40 for a single. The rate will settle down in the middle of the race to 32-38 for an eight, 28-34 for a single. Finishing stroke rates can go as high as 46.

**Tight Puddles:** When the oar is in the water it should not dive too deep or wash out across the top of the water. The "puddle" around the oar should be tight and powerful.

## OARS

Oars move the boat through the water and act as balancers. Rowing oars, over 370cm long, are approximately 90cm longer than sculling oars. Although there are still many standard oarblades, a recent development is the big blade, hatchet or cleaver which is 20 per cent larger than the standard blade.

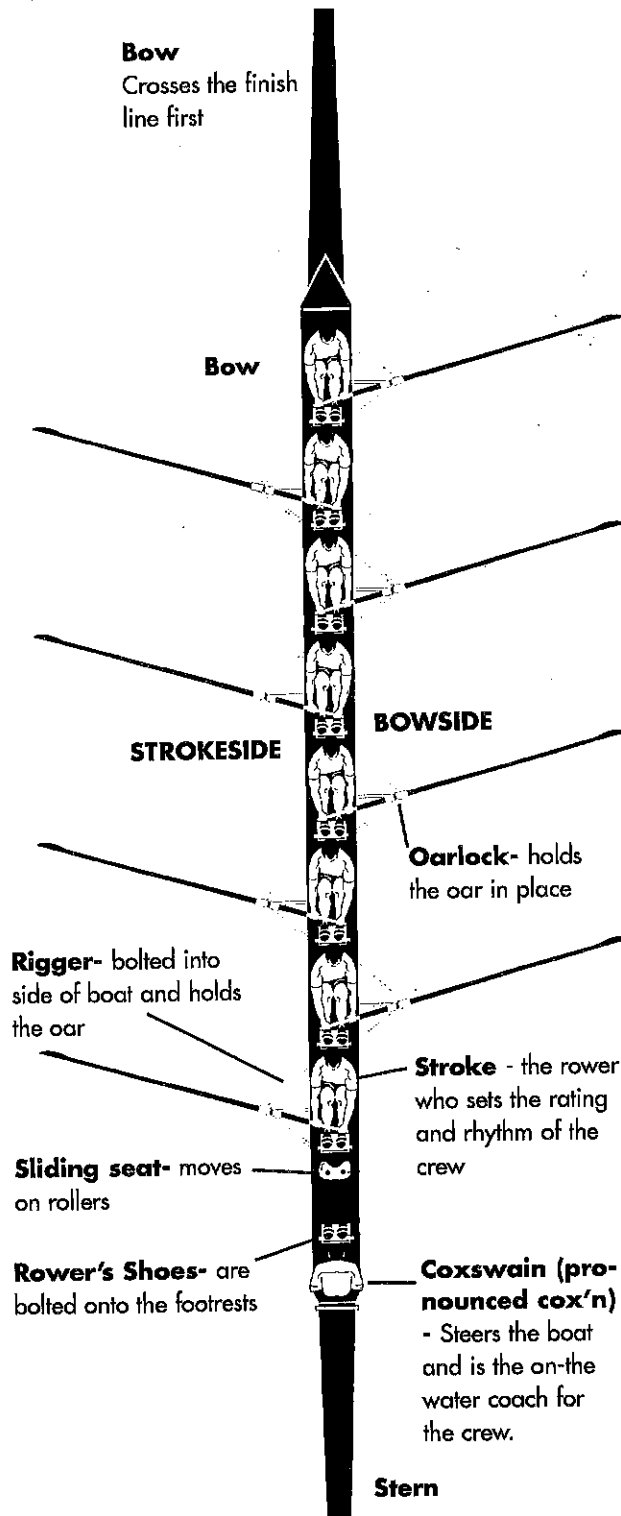
**Blades:** There are several different blade shapes.

1. Sweep oar with Standard Blade: Has a spoon like symmetrical shape.
2. Sweep Oar with Cleaver Blade: Shaped like a cleaver or hatchet, it is 20 per cent larger than the standard blade and designed to be more efficient.

**Materials:** Oars have traditionally been made in wood. Today most are made of synthetic materials like carbon fibre. These are stiffer and lighter.

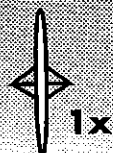

**Scull weight:** 1400 grams

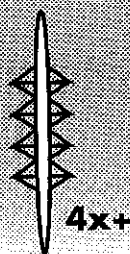


## Coxed Eight

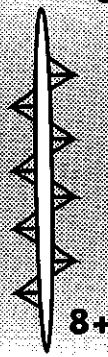
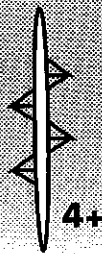
### Single Scull



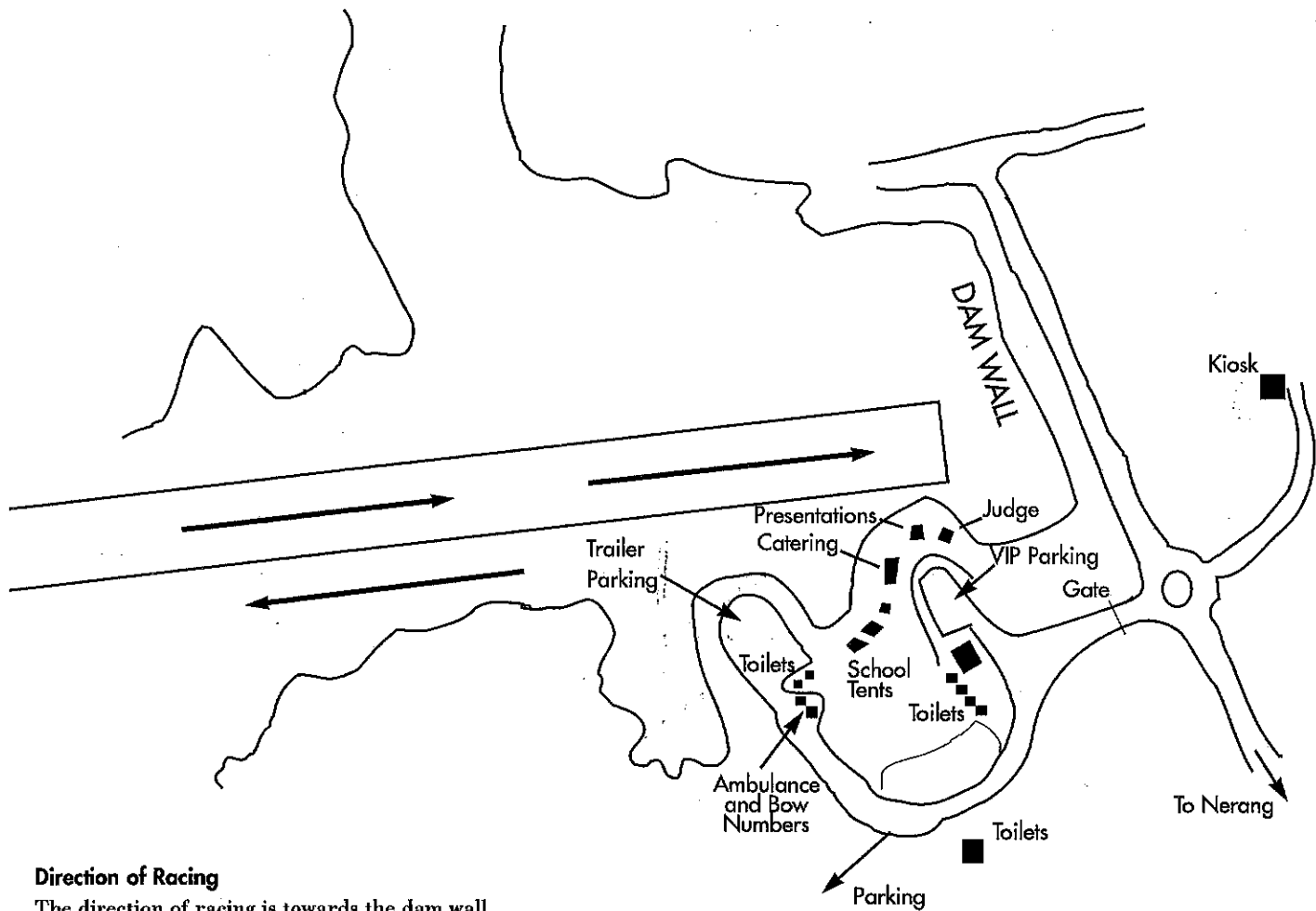
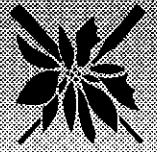
### Coxed Quad Scull

# COURSE MAP



## Direction of Racing

The direction of racing is towards the dam wall.

## Traffic Rules

All movement not in racing must be off the course. Crews must travel to the start off the course on the judges side (ie. crews must not cross the course). Crews must clear the finish area as soon as possible after their event.

Failure to follow these traffic rules will lead to disqualification.

## Lanes

Lanes number from the Judges side of the course (Spectator side). Lane number 1 is closest to the Judges' Tent.

## Race Distance

Four, Quad and Single Races will be 1000 metres. Eights races will be 2000 metres.

## Judges

The Judges tent is located on the spectator side of the course, at the finishing line.

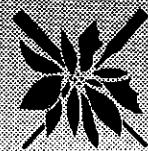
