I wish to congratulate all rowers, coaches, and their extended communities of supporters for bringing to life what is always a spectacular season of sport.


We look forward and wish everyone the best of luck for the upcoming season and of course the Head of River on Saturday 26 August.



Spectating at the Lead Up Regattas

Regatta's take up a great deal of your time. Wyaralong is a remote location. It's important that you are prepared to make it the best experience.

Bring a camp chair, a hat, sunscreen, \$5 for the parking, \$\$\$ for a coffee and snacks, the Saturday paper and a relaxed attitude. Most of the personnel conducting the regattas are volunteers. Please be patient...

Your school supporters will erect a tent on the spectator headland. The map on the back page shows the location.

The shuttle Bus is FREE. It operates every 15 minutes. The last race is at approximately 12:50pm. The last shuttle is at 1:20pm. Please do not expect the shuttle to run later than this as the shuttle buses are transporting athletes back to their schools schools. We cannot hold them up.

Head of the River

Parking and traffic management generally, is a tricky logistic at Wyaralong. The BSRA member schools all arrange supporter buses for this event, and you are encouraged to book a seat for you, your family, friends, interested parties. This way you will get to enjoy the day without the headache of sitting in a traffic jam. Please look out for this detail in your school communications.
