Go to the BSRA website for calendar, race schedules, pre-pay parking link, program, race draw, race results, competitor info and spectator info as well as maps and directions.



The spectator shuttle service is run by the BSRA and operates as soon as the relevant car park is opened. You can get a shuttle to/from your car park to/from the Ring Road consistently at peak times and every 15 minutes in the down times. The shuttle runs for 30 minutes after the last race (approx. 1:20pm). The buses used for the spectator shuttle are also the transport home for the competitors. We cannot hold them up.


HEAD OF THE RIVER
