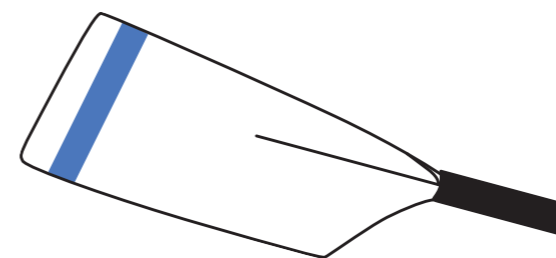


The spectator shuttle service is run by the BSRA and operates as soon as the relevant car park is opened. The shuttle runs for 30 minutes after the last race (approx. 1:20pm). The buses used for the spectator shuttle are also the transport home for the competitors. We cannot hold them up.

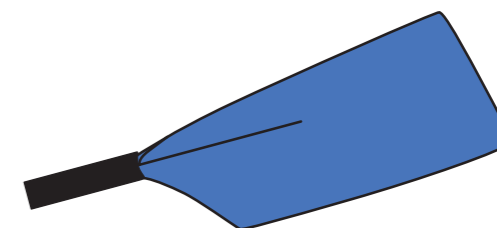
HEAD OF THE RIVER
