

GUIDE FOR SUPERVISORS

The BSRA recommends that all Schools nominate 2-3 coaches or staff members to supervise the students, both competitors and spectators, at the event.

School supervisors focus is to ensure that acceptable behaviour as outline below is followed:

1. Please ensure that the facility is treated with respect and all rubbish removed when the event concludes.
2. Please do not allow food into the venue. Food is to be consumed outside in the service area.
3. Sometimes the girls wear 'war paint' on their faces. Please make sure that this is not left on the seating and surrounds. If cleaning is required, your individual school will be billed for the service.
4. The girls are not permitted to stand on the seats.
5. The walkway between the stage and the spectator area can be occupied by the girls cheering on their fellow rowers. This should be monitored to ensure it doesn't get out of hand.
6. The seating plan for your school is on a separate document as is the detailed timing for the evening.
7. The event is held from 5:00pm to 8:00pm. Supervision is required for any School students when they are on site.
